

CLCSF Safety Plan & Protocols for 2020 Sailing Camp

Covid-19 Guidelines

This overview is designed to provide CLCSF directors, staff, and all participants with practical guidance, policies, and protocols which will be implemented to reduce potential exposure to and spread of the virus that causes COVID-19. We will be guided by specific recommendations provided by the CDC and New York State in relation to risk reduction at summer camps. The objective of this guidance is to ensure the health and well-being of those involved in our programs and our larger Chautauqua Lake community.

Check-In Procedures

It is understood that no one shall enter the Richard O. Hartley building or property if any symptoms or suspected cases of the virus are currently present for that individual or within the individual's family living unit.

- Check-In will occur on the Richard O. Hartley Park dock entrance.
- Until temperature has been checked, please arrive and maintain a distance of 6 feet from other participants not in your social distancing circle. Groups within the program shall be limited to 9 participants and 1 adult.
- Upon arrival, participants will have their temperature taken via a touchless thermometer. The
 CLCSF Sailing Director will also take the temperature of all staff working that day. All
 temperatures for participants and staff will be logged. Any person with a temperature above
 100.4 deg F will not be permitted to participate that day and not permitted to return until their
 temperature returns to under 100 deg F and no other COVID symptoms are present.
- All parents/guardians will be asked the following questions each time they drop off their child.
 If a parent /guardian answers yes, their child will not be allowed to stay.
 - Have you or anyone else in your house traveled to another country in the past 14 days?
 - Have you been in contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with, tested for, or quarantined as a result of COVID-19?
 - Are you experiencing symptoms of illness such as cough, fever, shortness of breath?

Facility & Grounds

The Richard O. Hartley Park Building will be available for restroom facilities while the Coach or another adult is on-shore for camp participants only; however use of the storage lockers will not be permitted. A limit of 2 people in the restrooms at a time is in effect to maintain social distance. Participants are reminded to bring a small duffle or other bag with any necessary personal items, and to not bring valuables.

- Hand sanitizer will be made available to all participants and all staff/participants are required to sanitize their hands upon arrival after their temperature check. Hand sanitizing will be requested and made available regularly throughout the day. CLCSF strongly advises that individuals refrain from touching their face.
- Participants are required to wear face coverings while on-shore (i.e. buff or disposable mask).
 Participants will be provided with a sailing buff on their first day. It is recommended to wash the buff after each use. If the participants does not have a face covering or one becomes damaged during use, a disposable mask will be provided while supplies last. Those refusing to wear a face covering while on-shore will be asked to leave. Masks are not required to be worn while sailing on the water.
- Social distancing efforts will not prevent or hinder water safety or rescue protocols from being followed (e.g. first aid, CPR, assistance to get boats on/off water, assistance to pull a participant out of the water into a safety boat, etc.)
- Boats will be assigned daily to a participant and will not be used by anyone else that day unless the boat(s) can be cleaned and sanitized properly between uses within a single day.
